

**What you need to earn in order to be awarded the IB Diploma
(new regulations starting with May 2015 DP Candidates)**

1. Candidate must meet the CAS requirements.
2. Candidate's total points must be 24 or greater.
3. Candidate cannot receive an "N" for theory of knowledge, extended essay or for a contributing subject.
4. Candidate cannot earn a grade of "E" for either TOK or EE (see TOK/EE Score Table Below).
5. Candidate cannot earn a grade of "1" in a subject/level.
6. Candidate cannot earn a grade of "2" three or more times (HL or SL).
7. Candidate cannot earn a grade "3" (or below) four or more times (HL or SL).
8. Candidate must gain 12 or more points on HL subjects (for candidates who register for four HL subjects, the three highest grades count).
9. Candidate must gain 9 or more points on SL subjects (candidates who register for two SL subjects must gain at least 5 points at SL).

TOK/EE Score Table

TOK/EE	A	B	C	D	E
A	3	3	2	2	FC
B	3	2	2	1	FC
C	2	2	1	0	FC
D	2	1	0	0	FC
E	FC	FC	FC	FC	FC

This matrix indicates that a grade of "E" on either the EE or in the TOK course is disqualification for an IB Diploma as it results in a "Failing Condition" (FC). Additional points can be earned by the candidate as long as candidate earns a score combination of D & B or better.
