

Taking the Written Permit Test for NYS Driver's Permit at Harrison High School

About the NYS Learner Permit Test

Students who are 15 years or older* can take the **Learner Permit Test** given by New York State's Department of Motor Vehicles at Harrison High School over the Internet. The test is offered in Spanish or English and results are immediate. Students who pass the online test will get a receipt and other forms which they can take to any DMV office upon their 16th birthday and apply for a permit (see below for office location information). Students who do not pass the test can retake the test as many times as is necessary.

**Students are encouraged to wait until they are within 3 months and no more than 5 months of their 16th birthday before signing up to take the test.*

Taking the Test at Harrison High School

The Learner Permit exam is administered during exam weeks (both midterm exams and final exams) with two additional days made available in Fall and Spring as needed. **Students must pre-register with the Harrison High School Library.** The exam is given in the computer lab (D115) on the appointed day and is offered for several sessions in order to accommodate all students. Because of computer availability and test security, only 18 students are eligible to take the test at one time. Four sessions are generally available on each testing day.

Students must bring proof of identification on the day of test. The **only** acceptable forms of identification are:

- Birth Certificate/Passport (photocopy accepted)
- School photo ID
- NYSDMV-issued document

The test will not be administered without proof of identification.

Following the DMV's decision stop giving the written permit test in the White Plains DMV, Harrison High School arranged to have students take the written permit test here at the high school at no charge. Many students take advantage of this service which allows them to avoid the hassle of taking the test at the Department of Motor Vehicles offices in either Yonkers or Peekskill. The HHS Library offers this service as a courtesy and balances the service with the need to support daily educational activities at the school so as not to interfere with instruction.

2016-2017 Permit Test Schedule at Harrison High School:

November 22nd, 2015 Periods 4-7

Students who will turn 16 prior to January 23rd should plan to take the test November 22.

January 23rd-January 27th 2017

(Times to be determined based on Mid-Term Schedule)

Students who will turn 16 prior to June 12 should plan to take the test in January

June 13th - June 20th 2017

(Times to be determined based on Finals Schedule)

Students who will turn 16 prior to Nov. 22 of 2017 should plan to take the test in June

An additional testing date may be scheduled if needed to accommodate the Driver's Education schedule however it is expected that students will try to plan according to the dates provided here.
