

College Entrance Exam Testing Recommendations

COLLEGE ENTRANCE EXAMS TESTING RECOMMENDATIONS

College entrance exams play a critical role in the college admissions process. Throughout high school we recommend you discuss specific entrance exam plans with your counselor. To assist you and your child in this process we recommend the following highlighted testing schedule. We strongly recommend that you outline your plans with your counselor prior to registering.

Exams	Recommended Administration Dates
PLAN	November: (10 th grade) <i>This is the Practice ACT and is designed by ACT for 10th grade students.</i>
PSAT	October: (11 th grade) <i>This is the Practice SAT for all 11th grade students. Some students may wish to take this in 10th grade given their advanced standing in mathematics. Confirm with your counselor before registering.</i>

SAT¹ (Verbal, Math & Writing)	10 th Grade: Not Recommended
	11 th Grade: March OR May OR June
	12 th Grade: October OR November OR December

¹*It is recommended that students sit for this exam in spring of grade 11 AND fall of grade 12.*

ACT²	10 th Grade: Not Recommended
	11 th Grade: April OR June
	12 th Grade: September OR October

²*It is recommended that students sit for this exam once.*

SAT II³ (formerly Subject Tests)	SAT II in World History <i>(Best taken in May or June while enrolled in AP World History)</i>
	SAT II in US History <i>(Best taken in May or June while enrolled in AP US History)</i>
	SAT II in Biology, SAT II in Chemistry and SAT II in Physics <i>(Best taken in May or June while enrolled in respective AP Science Course. Some students may wish to prepare prior to an AP course. Plans should be discussed with your counselor to ensure careful guidance.)</i>
	SAT II in Math Level 1 and or SAT II in Math Level 2 <i>(Best taken in May or June while enrolled in most relevant course. Level 1 corresponds best to Math B or Algebra II Trigonometry. Level 2 corresponds to Pre-Calc BC or AP Calc AB or AP Calc BC)</i>
	SAT II in Languages Chinese, German, Spanish, Italian, French, Korean, Japanese, Latin and Hebrew <i>(Best taken in May or June while enrolled in respective AP Language Course or in May of junior year if language is natural to the student)</i>
	SAT II in Literature <i>(Best taken in May while enrolled in AP English Literature and Composition)</i>
