Dear Parents,

We have received information from the Greenwich School District alerting us that two incidents of a student being approached by a stranger in a white van have been reported to the Greenwich Police. On January 12th a 17 year old student reported that as he was walking home after getting off the school bus an older white male in a white van stopped and asked for directions. The student told the man he was unfamiliar with the address he was looking for. The man told the student to get in the van. The student fled the area.

A second incident occurred on January 13th. In this incident a 9 year old student in the North Street area of Greenwich was awaiting his bus when an older white male in a white van stopped and asked him for directions. The boy was unfamiliar with the location and explained that to the man. The man told the boy to get in the van. This student also fled the area.


The description of the individual is of a white male in his late forties, balding with gray hair on the sides and thick eyeglasses driving a white van. Both students are fine and unharmed.

Administrators have been made aware of these events and faculty and staff will remain on a heightened state of alert. Our Police Department has been in contact with the Greenwich Police Department and will take all the appropriate steps to insure the safety of our students.

Parents should take this opportunity to review with all of their children regardless of age the need to be alert for strangers and to immediately report any incidents to adults.

The district will notify you in the event of any additional information.
